### What you need to know...

- You Must PRE-REGISTER for this drive-in clinic. Registration deadline: 3/23/24
- Animals must be at least 3 months old to receive their first rabies vaccine shot.
- NYS requires animals over 4 months old be vaccinated for rabies.
- Microchips and Distemper Vaccines will be available at this clinic at no cost through Chaut. Co Humane Society.

#### **Clinic Day:**

- Please arrive at your specified appointment time.
- **Bring previous rabies vaccination record** to the clinic to receive a 3-year vaccination.
- People & pets will stay in vehicles. Animal handlers will transport pets from vehicle to veterinarian for vaccination.
- Dogs must be on a leash, small dogs may be in carriers.
- Cats must be in a container (carrier, kennel, etc.)
