

**LEGAL NOTICE
ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS
TOWN OF CHAUTAUQUA**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Town of Chautauqua, New York, will hold a public hearing on Tuesday February 18th, 2025, beginning at 3:30pm, in the Veteran's Memorial Room, located at 2 Academy Street, Mayville, New York 14757 for the following actions:

3:30pm: To act on the appeal of James McCroskey for two existing sheds on property. The property is located at 6479 Sandalwood Lane in Mayville and designated on the official Chautauqua County tax map as Section(s) 246.13 Block 2 Lot 55. The project requires variances for Shed #1 - side yard east setback distance, rear roadway setback, Shed #2 – side yard east setback distance, rear roadway setback distance.

3:40pm: To act on the appeal of James McCroskey for construction of an attached deck structure onto lakeside front of existing house. The property is located at 6479 Sandalwood Lane in Mayville and designated on the official Chautauqua County tax map as Section(s) 246.13 Block 2 Lot 55. The project requires variances for lot size, lot coverage, side yard east setback distance.

3:50pm: To act on the appeal of 1200 Group, LLC c/o Ellicott Development Company for establishment of a Planned Unit Development (PUD), requiring a Special Use Permit. The property is located at 5621 E. Lake Road and designated on the official Chautauqua County tax map as Section(s) 263.15 Block 1 Lot 22, 263.10-2-2.3, 263.10-2-2.1, 263.15-1-22 which is the location of the former Chautauqua Point Golf Course. The ZBA will be re reviewing the Site Plan for this meeting, as well as any changes to the site plan from the previous meeting on January 21st.
